Major Changes to 2024 NFPA-70E

A review of each significant change to the latest 2024 70e edition with discussion of practical impacts in the field and organizations electrical safety programs. Discussion will include the three “global” changes to 70e, updates to content and tables in each article, as well as the addition of Informative Annex S. Staying up to date with changes to 70e is required training for every Qualified and Unqualified person exposed to electrical hazards in the workplace.
