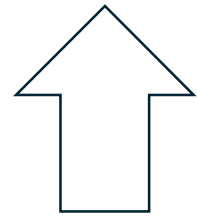

North

- 0 mile - At west side corner of King County kiosk sign (nearest to trail) AND at 7' north of trail tee (north side of trail).
- 1 mile – 15' south of 1st 3 trees AND 10' north of 2nd of 3 trees AND 60' north of 3' green post (Metro Sewer Manhole)
- 2 mile – 50' south of side back side of bench AND 10' south of two big rocks (3' x 3') between both
- 3 mile – 200' south of Link Light rail overhead bridge (south edge) AND 120' north of green 3' pole (Metro Sewer MH)
- 4 mile – 18' south of 'Marymoor Station Train' sign white letters, blue background AND in line with 15 mph sign white with black letters
- 5 mile – 2' north of 'Critical Area' sign blue with white letters/symbols AND 3' north of light on street pole on Lake Sammamish Parkway SE
- 6 mile – 16' north of 'No trespassing' City of Sammamish sign white w/colorful letters/symbols background AND 39' south of wall/fence
- 7 mile 10' north of 'Limited Sight' sign yellow with black letters AND 25' north of bollards @ 2825 NW Schleep Street
- 8' mile – 37' north of staircase AND 3' north of signal lights on Lake Sammamish Parkway SE
- 9 mile - @154 East Lake Sammamish Pkwy SE Stop sign AND 10' north of 'Critical Area' sign green with white letters AND 5' south of trail bollards
- 10 mile – 21' north of gate opening north side, 12' north of 'Critical Area' sign green with white letters
- 11 mile @ black fence opening AND 11' north of Transformer pole AND 21' north of trail bollard (reflectors)
- Mile 12 – 12' North of Telephone pole, AND 14' south of black gate fence corner
- Mile 13 – 2' North of Stop sign AND 3' south of trail bollards @ 4433 East Lake Sammamish Parkway SE AND 8' south of north side of Sammamish State Park entrance (boat launch)
- Mile 13.1 (26.2 TA) – 30' north of deer crossing sign yellow with black symbols AND 50' south of transformer pole 22' south of 40 mph sign white white with black letters AND In line with transformer pole on Lake Sammamish Pkwy SE
- Mile 14 – 6' North of trail bollards AND 25' south of yellow crossing sign with black symbols
- Mile 15 – 40' north of yellow cross sign with black symbols, 2' south of transformer pole, AND 10' south of rock wall starts and black fence.
- 16 mile - 3' north of stairs, gray railing, AND 36' north of gate opening/white block fence
- 17 mile - @ 333 East Lake Sammamish Pkwy AND 2' north of clean out Carson box round gray AND 4' north of 'Critical Area' sign green with white letters

18 mile – 5' north of clean out (round Carson box in ground gray cover) AND 8' north of water drain AND 25' north of 'Watch for Peds' sign yellow with black symbols AND 25' north of 15 mph sign white with black letters AND in line with transformer pole on East Lake Sammamish Pkwy SE

19 mile – 7' south of south side poof black roller gate AND 100' south of trail crossing sign + black symbols yellow background

20 mile - @clean out (round box in ground Carson gray) AND 16' north of north end of brown house edge

21 mile – 14' south of 'Critical Area' sign blue with white letters AND 24' north of transformer pole on Lake Sammamish Pkwy

22 mile – 8' south of blue 3' mile marker sign with white letters AND 10' north of middle huge Elm tree AND 120' south of 20 mph sign white with black letters

Mile 23 - 25' north of white reflector pole AND 20' south of mile post 30 white letters blue background

Mile 24 – 'Build a better place for salmon' sign 15' north of full color sign AND 25' north of green irrigation box in ground

25 mile – South of trail repaired trail 'marking'. There are two back strips the south line has course marking nail in it AND 110' south of green pole (metro sewer MH)

26 mile @ 3' south of fence opening door (right post) AND 10' north of tree line

26.2 At west side corner of King County kiosk sign (nearest to trail) AND at 7' north of trail tee (north side of trail).
